- The portal currently allows leadership to search for and sort member information. This information is updated every night. We've greatly appreciated your patience as we've gotten up to this point. We encourage you to send us your feedback in these early stages. We've heard your requests to have credit card payments, and that is our biggest priority.
- Security: Security is a priority that we are currently navigating with ITS, so that leaders will have access only to their chapter members' information.
